

File operations

ls [<path>]	List files and directories <i>Useful options:</i>
<i>-l</i>	<i>long / wide view</i>
<i>-a</i>	<i>show hidden files and directories</i>
<i>-h</i>	<i>human-readable sizes</i>
<i>-R</i>	<i>show directory content recursively</i>
<i>-b</i>	<i>show escape chars in names</i>
<i>-ltr</i>	<i>reverse sort files by modified date</i>

Use --help to show additional options

touch <file>	create empty file
cat <file1> [<file2>]	dump contents of file1 to stdout concat file1 & file2 to stdout
head <file>	dump first 10 lines of file to stdout
tail <file>	dump last 10 lines of file to stdout

Directory Operations

cd [dir]	change directory
mkdir [/dir/path]	make directory <i>-p with parent dirs as needed</i>
