

Navigating

```
visit('/projects')  
visit(post_comments_path(post))
```

Clicking Buttons & Links

```
click_link('id-of-link')  
click_link('Link Text')  
click_button('Save')  
click('Link Text')  
# Click either a link or a button  
click('Button Value')
```

Sync, Async & Wait...

Capybara automatically waits for asynchronous operations to complete. When you try to find an element that isn't on the page, it waits and retries until it is there, or a timeout duration elapses. The wait time is defined at `Capybara.default_wait_time`

Here are the methods that waits:

```
find(selector), find_field, find_link within(selector)  
(scoping) *has_selector?/has_no_selector? & assertions  
form & link actions click_link/button fill_in  
check/uncheck, select, choose
```

Here are the methods that doesn't wait:

```
visit current_path all (selector) first(selector)  
execute_script simple accessors: text, value, title, etc.
```

Interacting with forms

```
fill_in('First Name', :with => 'John')  
fill_in('Password', :with => 'Seekrit')  
fill_in('Description', :with => 'Really Long Text...')  
choose('A Radio Button')  
choose("radio_group_selector", option: "Option 5")  
check('A Checkbox')  
uncheck('A Checkbox')  
attach_file('Image', '/path/to/image.jpg')  
select('Option', :from => 'Select Box')
```

Scoping

```
within("//li[@id='employee']") do  
  fill_in 'Name', :with => 'Jimmy'  
end  
within(:css, "li#employee") do  
  fill_in 'Name', :with => 'Jimmy'  
end  
within_fieldset('Employee') do  
  fill_in 'Name', :with => 'Jimmy'  
end  
within_table('Employee') do  
  fill_in 'Name', :with => 'Jimmy'  
end
```
