Detective Fiction changes in policing, both locally and globally, and the cultural discomfort that surrounded those changes. The public increasingly perceived military engagement across the globe as unsettling, and transformations of policing at home occurred as well.

Romantic Period (1st and 2nd generation) a movement in the arts and literature that originated in the late 18th century, emphasizing inspiration, subjectivity, and the primacy of the individual. Second Gen - passion and emotion, incorporating so much more into intuitive thought, the supernatural, and exotic, greatly influence, also, by classical Greek and Roman literature. First Gen - saw the transition in France from prerevolution, revolution, Napoleon

French Revolution beginning of a change in the current ways of society and helping to improve the lives of the oppressed.


