ls -lha [dir(s)]	(l)ist (h)uman readable sizes with (a)hidden files
pwd	show path to working directory
cd [dir]	change directory to [dir]
touch [file_name(s)]	create empty file
mkdir [dir(s)]	create directory(ies)
rmdir [dir(s)]	remove directory(ies)
rm [file(s)]	remove file
rm -fr [files/dir(s)]	(f)orce remove files (r)ecursively
cp [source] [dest]	copy file
mv [source] [dest]	move/rename file
cat [file]	Concatenate file to standard output
less [file]	Page through text
head [file]	Output the first part of files (10 lines)
tail [file]	Output the last part of files (10 lines)
tail -f [file]	Output appended data as file grows
