To talk in present about habits, daily routines, general facts/truths, future plans, programmed events

Structure

Affirmative Subject + verb+ complement

Negative Subject + aux **do/does not** + verb+ complement

Interrogative Aux **do/does** + subject + verb+ complement

(He She It) **Does** (I,you,we,they) **Do**

Adverbs of frequency

Always	100%	Usually	80%
--------	------	---------	-----

Often	70%	Sometimes	50%
-------	-----	-----------	-----

Occasionally	30%	Seldom	20%
--------------	-----	--------	-----

Rarely/Hardly	5%	Never	0%
---------------	----	-------	----

Use of -s and -es in Third Person

* En la tercera persona del singular, el verbo siempre termina en -s:
he wants, she needs, he gives, she thinks.

* Verbos que terminan en -y: se cambia la -y por -ies:

fly --> flies, cry --> cries

* Añadimos -es a los verbos que terminan en: -ss, -x, -sh, -ch:

he passes, she catches, he fixes, it pushes
