

Attaching a Shell

Attaching a Bash shell to an already running container:

```
docker exec -it my_container /bin/bash
```

Most used

<code>docker ps</code>	List <i>running</i> containers
<code>docker ps -a</code>	List <i>all</i> containers
<code>docker pull <image></code>	Pull <image>
<code>docker images</code>	List pulled (local) images
<code>docker rmi <image></code>	Remove <image>

Blocks of `<...>` are just placeholders and need to be replaced with an actual value.

Publish Images

```
docker save <my_image> | ssh -C  
user@my.remote.host.com docker load
```
