# Prototype

Acarbose

## Action

Slows the absorption of Carbohydrates form the GI tract

#### Indication

Can be used in patients with Type 1 or 2 Diabetes

#### Contraindications

Do not give to patients with inflammatory or malabsorption GI disorder

#### Administration

Must be given with first bite of meal... no food=no med

PO (does not need to be taken with meals)

# **Nursing Interventions**

Monitor CBC, A1C, & LFTs

Must use glucose tablets for hypoglycemia

# Adverse Effects

Flatus

GI distress

Pancytopenia

Hepatotoxicity

## Normal lab values

A1C <6.5 = diabetic goal

CBC Platelet = 150-400 WBC = 4-11,

HCT 36-51, Hgb = 12-17

LFTs AST = 10-40, ALT = 7-56
