

Basic playback controls

x	Play
c	Pause
v	Stop
b	Next
z	Previous
left, right	Seek +- 5 seconds
.,	Seek +- 1 min

Using the queue

4	Go to queue
1	Go back to library
e	Add to queue (bottom)
shift-e	Add to queue (top)
delete or shift-d	Remove from queue

If something is added to the queue, it will play next!

Playback behavior

s	Toggle shuffle
shift-c	Toggle continue (use this if you want to stop after each song)
m	Toggle artist / album / all

Navigate

↓ ↑	Up / down arrows
Fn + ↓ ↑	Hold "fn" and press the up / down arrows
Tab	Navigate between the artist list / song list
Spacebar	Expand the artist list

Search

/	Open search (at very bottom), then type something, then press return
n	Next search result
shift-n	Previous search result

Change View

1	Artists & Albums
3	Playlists
4	Queue
5	File browser

Advanced playback behavior

r	Toggle repeat
Ctrl-r	Toggle repeat current
t	Toggle show remaining time
o	Toggle play sorted
f	Toggle display follows now playing

If something goes wrong you might need these

Creating a playlist

3	Go to playlists
1	Go to library
:pl-create	Create playlist with name
<name>	<name>
y	Add to current playlist
Spacebar	Select current playlist

Use these commands if you want a permanent playlist. If you just want a temporary one for right now, use the queue.
