## Angles

1:1	DFE
3/4:1	DFE
CAT Surgery	DFE

**Open Angles:** can cause glaucoma or mess up the refraction. Check with provider for younger patients.

## Follow Up Schedule

**Spectacle/CL Rx** RTC in 1 year

**Glaucoma (POAG)** RTC q 3 months (*4x a year*)

1. Full Exam	2. 3m IOP	3. 3m OCT/VF/ Gonio	4. 3m IOP
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**AMD** RTC q 6 months

1. CEE	2. 6m MAC/OCT/DFE
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### Choroidal Nevus

1. CEE (Fundus)	2. 3m f/u (DFE/F-UNDUS) if new	*if stable can go back to 1x a year at CEE
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### CATS

- always dilate
- always wants optos
- HX of DED do tearlab
- Evals need DFE & Auto
- Can watch yearly or 6m
