Acids and Bases

Arrhenius Acid: produces H⁺ ions in water

Arrhenius Base: Produced OH ions in

water

Bronsted Acid: Proton (H+) donor

Bronsted Base: Proton (H⁺) acceptor/rec-

eiver

Strong Acids: Donate 100% of Goes to the H⁺ ion in water completion

Weak Acids: Donates less than 100% on H⁺

ions in water

2H2O<->H3O⁺+OH⁻



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
