#### Move Mental Checklist

Do I have any checking moves?

If Yes, do they accomplish anything?

Can I be checked?

Are any of my pieces hanging or underdefended?

Does my opponent have any weaknesses I can exploit?

Are there any tactics open to me?

e.g., Discovered attacks, Forks, Pins, Skewers

Can I move any pieces to a more active position?

Can I occupy or control any outpost<sup>1</sup> squares or open files?

Can I blockade an enemy's knight or bishop with a pawn push?

<sup>1</sup> An outpost is a square on the fourth, fifth, sixth, or seventh rank which is protected by a pawn and which cannot be attacked by an opponent's pawn.

- 2. Nf3 Nc6
- 3. Bb5

### Morphy Defence

3. ... a6

(Exchange Variation) No material advantage:

- 4. Bxc6 dxc6
- Nxe5 Qd4 Qd4 forks the knight and pawn.

(Open Defence)

- 4. Ba4 Nf6
- 5. 0-0 Nxe4

#### Italian Game

- 1. e4 e5
- 2. Nf3 Nc6
- 3. Bc4

(Giuoco Piano)

- 3. ... Bc5
  - ::: (Main Line)
- 4. c3
  - ::: (Evans Gambit)
- 4. b4 If ... Bxb4, 5.c3. If ... Bb6, 5.a4 a6.
  - ::: (Giuoco Pianissimo)
- 4. d3
  - :: (Four Knights Variation)
- 4. Nc3 Nf6

(Two Knights Defense)

3. ... Nf6



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
