Line Ctrl + A	< To the beginning of the line.	
Line Ctrl + E	> To the End of the line.	
Word Alt + B	< One word Backward.	
Word Alt + F	> One word Forward.	
Char Ctrl + B	< One character Backward.	
Char Ctrl + F	> One character Forward.	
Delete		
Lino Ctrl + II	Eraca avarything from the current cursor position	

Delete	
Line Ctrl + U	< Erase everything from the current cursor position to the beginning of the line.
Line Ctrl + K	> Erase everything from the current cursor position to the end of the line.
Word Alt + D	> The word after the cursor.
Word Alt + Delete	< The word before the cursor.
Word Alt + Backspace	The last word.
Word Ctrl + W	Delete the command or word preceding the cursor.
Char Ctrl + H	< Remove the last character typed.
Ctrl + Y	Paste the deleted text on the current cursor position.
