

Navigation

edit mode to modify content `Enter`

command mode to run code `Escape`

Use `Esc` and `Enter` to toggle between command and edit mode. Notice the cell input border becomes blue in edit mode (grey in command mode).

when in command mode

use cursor keys to navigate

insert cell **above** `a`

insert cell **below** `b`

delete cell `dd`

when in Edit mode

tab completion `Tab`

toggle **line comment** `Cmd + /`

in parenthesis of function to **display docstring** `Shift + Tab`

Running code, getting help

run cell and put cursor below `Shift + Enter`

run cell and stay in cell `Control + Enter`

get help / information on object / method `?name_of_object (e.g. "?print")`

To run a cell of code, hit `Shift + Enter`. This executes the cell and puts the cursor in the next cell below (or makes a new one if you are at the end). Alternatively, you can use `Control + Enter` to execute the cell and keep the cursor in the same cell.
