

Attributes of Mercy according to Kabbalah:

#	Attribute	Description
1	א-ל	G-d — mighty in compassion to give all creatures according to their need;
2	רחום	rachum — merciful, that humankind may not be distressed
3	חנון	ve'chanun — and gracious if humankind is already in distress
4	אריך אפים	erech apayim — slow to anger; (once, to the righteous)
5	אריך אפים	erech apayim — slow to anger; (repeated again for the wicked)
6	רב-חסד	ve'rav chesed — and plenteous in kindness
7	אמת	ve'emet — and truth
8	נצר חסד	notzer chesed — keeping kindness
9	לא אלפים	laalafim — unto thousands
10	נשא עון	noseh avon — forgiving iniquity
11	נפשח	vafeshah — and transgression
12	חטאה	vechata'ah — and sin
13	נקה	venakeh — and pardoning
