
Introduction

Mnemonic abcde	
Assess	Description
a: asymmetry	is the mole irregular in shape?
b: border	is the border irregular, notched, or poorly defined?
c: color	does the color vary (for example, between shades of brown, red, white, blue, or black)?
d: diameter	is the diameter more than 6 mm?
e: evolving	Any change — in size, shape, color, elevation, or another trait, or any new symptom such as bleeding, itching or crusting?
