

### Fall Risk Factor Category 1

Scoring not completed for the following reason (s) (check any that apply):

- ☐ Patient has experienced a fall during this hospitalization
- ☐ Patient has a history of more than one fall within 6 months before admission
- ☐ Patient is deemed a high risk per protocol (e.g. seizures)
- ☐ Patient has a lack of understanding of one's physical and cognitive limitations

### Fall Risk Factor Category 2

For those patients who are not in the above category, complete the following risk assessment tool and calculate fall risk score. If no box is checked, the score for the category is 0.

### Fall History

- pts (select one)
- ☐ One fall within 6 months before admission (5 points)
- ☐ No falls (0 points)

### Elimination, Bowel and Bladder

- pts (select only one)
- ☐ No incontinence, urgency, or frequency (0 points)
- ☐ Incontinence (2 points)
- ☐ Urgency or frequency (2 points)
- ☐ Urgency/ frequency & incontinence (4 points)

### Medications:

- pts (select one)
- ☐ On 1 high fall risk drug (3 points)
- ☐ On 2 or more high fall risk drugs (5 points)
- ☐ Sedation procedure within past 24 hours (7 points)

Includes PCA/ opiates, anti-convulsants, anti-hypertensives, diuretics, hypnotics, laxatives, sedatives, and psychotropics

### Patient Care Equipment:

- pts (select one)
- ☐ One present (1 point)
- ☐ Two present (2 points)
- ☐ Three or more present (3 points)

Any equipment that tethers patient, e.g. IV infusion, chest tube, indwelling catheters, SCDs, etc.

### Mobility

- pts (Multiple select, choose all that may apply and add points together)
- ☐ Requires assistance or supervision for mobility, transfer, or ambulation (2 points)
- ☐ Unsteady gait (2 points)
- ☐ A visual or auditory impairment affecting mobility (2 points)

### Cognition

- pts (Multiple select, choose all that apply and add points together)
- ☐ Altered awareness of immediate physical environment (1 point)
- ☐ Impulsivity/ poor safety judgment (2 points)
- ☐ Short term memory loss (2 points)

### Total points scored

Moderate risk = 5-12 total points. High risk = 12 points or greater
