### S - Situation

Symptoms associated with antipsychotics:

- Blurred vision
- Constipation
- Dry mouth
- · Weight gain

### **B** - Background

• Indications (not limited to): Schizophrenia and bipolar disorder to control psychotic symptoms such as hallucinations, delusions, or mania.

· Other diagnoses, co-morbidities, other medications, recent medication changes, recent pertinent labs.

• Significant drug interactions: anticonvulsants, Parkinson's drugs, antihistamines, antidepressants, barbiturates, sleeping and pain medications, and narcotics.

### A - Assessment / Appearance

· Change in vital signs (e.g., decreased or increased blood pressure, increased pulse)

- · Skin color changes
- Change in behavior or mental status

#### **R** - Recommendations / Requests

Contact the resident's physician or practitioner to ask:

- · Do the changes reported indicate adverse effects of the medication?
- Is there an appropriate indication for use?
- Is use of the medication only for the duration needed, and at the lowest effective dose?
- · Is there effectiveness in achieving the therapy goal?
- · Drowsiness or sedation
- · Involuntary movements
- · Muscle spasms or tremors (can be severe)

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
