## Periods of Surgery

### PRE-OPERATIVE PERIOD

- Patient teaching
- Consent
- Physical prep.
- psychological prep.

### INTRA-OPERATIVE PERIOD

Nurse is patient advocate

**Scrub nurse:** maintains sterile nurse integrity and monitors equipment

**Circulating nurse:** Protects patient safety, monitors OR conditions, documents, monitor team activities

### POST-OPERATIVE PERIOD

To PACU

Recovery: clinical unit or discharged home

## Classification of Surgery

1. Emergency	Immediately
2. Urgent	24-30h
3. Required	Upcoming weeks
4. Elective	Should have
5. Optional	Not necessary
