git	
Undo last commit, unstage and remove changes	git resethard HEAD [^]
Undo last commit and unstage	git reset HEAD^
Undo last commit	git resetsoft HEAD^

HEAD refers to the tip of the currently checked-out branch.

The ^ is a notation which can be attached to any commit specifier and means "the commit before".
