Undo last commit, unstage and remove changes	<code>git reset --hard HEAD^</code>
Undo last commit and unstage	<code>git reset HEAD^</code>
Undo last commit	<code>git reset --soft HEAD^</code>

HEAD refers to the tip of the currently checked-out branch.

The ^ is a notation which can be attached to any commit specifier and means "the commit before".
