

### Reading Skills

Skills	Definition	Example
Predicting	It allows students to use information from the text, such as titles, headings, pictures and diagrams to anticipate what will happen in the story.	Reading the title of a book or the chapter of a book and try to guess what is going to happen using prior knowledge.
Finding the main idea, important facts, and supporting details	Finding all the relevant information to the good comprehension of a text.	Reading to make a summary.
Reading for specific information	Look exclusively for requested information.	Reading a text to answer a questionnaire.
Making inferences of new words from surrounding words and sentences	Is a comprehension strategy used by proficient readers to "read between the lines", make connections, and draw conclusions about the text's meaning and purpose.	Gathering all the information in a story and try to picture how it will end.
Recognizing the structure/sequence of a reading	It refers to the identification of the components of a story (the beginning, middle, and end).	Identify the parts of a novel.
Critical reading	Involves presenting a reasoned argument that evaluates and analyses what you have read.	Asking your self questions about the reading in order to reflect about them.

### Reading Skills (cont)

Fast/quick reading	It is the process of rapidly recognizing and absorbing phrases or sentences on a page all at once, rather than identifying individual words.	When we are looking for particular information.
Scanning	It is a reading technique to be used when you want to find specific information quickly. In scanning you have a question in your mind and you read a passage only to find the answer, ignoring unrelated information.	Reading to find the main idea or topic quickly.
Skimming	It refers to the process of reading only main ideas within a passage to get an overall impression of the content of a reading selection.	Looking for information to write an essay.

Reading	The ability to extract information from a written or printed source.
Skills	To possess the knowledge and ability to execute an activity or a task in a good way.
Reading Skills	The implementation of prior knowledge to extract all the information from a written or printed text.
