

Managing

<code>docker images -a</code>	to view all images
<code>docker ps -a</code>	to view all containers

Building/Running

<code>docker build -t {image_name} .</code>	to build an image from the docker file
<code>docker run {image_id}</code>	to run a container
<code>docker run -d {image_id}</code>	to run a container in background

Removing/Deleting

<code>docker rmi {image_id}</code>	to remove an image
<code>docker image prune</code>	to remove all unused images
<code>docker rm -f {container_id}</code>	to remove a running container
<code>docker container prune</code>	to remove all unused container
