

### Key Map

<b>M,</b>	Meta key, usually Esc. Press and release key.
<b>C+</b>	Ctrl key. Hold and press key(s) that follow.
<b>A+</b>	Alt key. Hold and press key(s) that follow.
<b>C+a</b>	Action w/multiple shortcuts, each on separate lines.
<b>Home</b>	Ex: <b>C+a</b> is one option, <b>Home</b> is another.

### Command History

<b>history [n]</b>	Display history (last n lines)
<b>C+p</b>	Display previous line in history
<b>UpArrow</b>	
<b>C+n</b>	Display next line in history
<b>DownArrow</b>	
<b>C+r(C+r)</b>	Reverse search <b>C+r</b> again will display previous match in history
<b>C+g</b>	Exit history search mode
<b>Esc</b>	
<b>C+o</b>	Execute the command found via <b>C+r</b> or <b>C+s</b>
<b>!!</b>	Execute last command
<b>!abc</b>	Execute last command that starts with <i>abc</i>
<b>^abc^def</b>	Execute previous command, replacing <i>abc</i> with <i>def</i>
<b>!abc:p</b>	Print last command that starts with <i>abc</i>
<b>M,(M,.)</b>	Print last argument from previous command <b>M,.</b> again will display last argument from previous command in history
<b>!\$</b>	Variable which contains the last argument of the previous command
<b>!*</b>	Variable which contains all arguments of the previous command

### Editing

<b>C+h</b>	Delete the character to the left of the cursor
<b>Backspace</b>	
<b>Del</b>	Delete the character to the right of (under) the cursor On an empty line, <b>C+d</b> exits the current shell
<b>M,C+h</b>	Cut the word to the left of the cursor
<b>M,Backspace</b>	
<b>C+d</b>	Cut the word to the right of the cursor
<b>M,d</b>	
<b>C+u</b>	Cut all characters to the left of the cursor
<b>C+k</b>	Cut all characters to the right of the cursor
<b>C+y</b>	Paste word or text that was cut using one of the deletion shortcuts
<b>M,l</b>	Convert the next word to lower case
<b>M,u</b>	Convert the next word to UPPER CASE
<b>M,c</b>	Convert the next word to Proper Case
<b>C+t</b>	Transpose the two characters on either side of the cursor and move right
<b>M,t</b>	Transpose the two words on either side of the cursor and move right
<b>C+vx</b>	Insert <i>x</i> literally, even if <i>x</i> is a special character
<b>C+_</b>	Revert/Undo previous edit
<b>M,r</b>	Revert/Undo all edits

### Expansion

<b>M,C+e</b>	Expand the current line as the shell would before execution
<b>C+iC+i</b>	If on first word of line, complete the command name.
<b>Tab</b>	If not on first word of line, complete the file name.
<b>C+i</b>	Show possible command/file name completions
<b>TabTab</b>
