General Long Term Liabilities

Debt & other long-term liabilities that arise from

Issuance of bonds and notes, and capital leases

activities of governmental

funds Long-term Claims and judgements, liabilities compensated absences, related to pensions, and other operating postemployment benefits, and activities obligations related to landfills and pollution remediation.

Pollution Remediation Obligations

Liabilities arising from cleanup of hazardous waste or hazardous substances resulting from existing pollution

Debt Service Funds

Fund that accounts for financial resources set aside for payment of principal and interest on general long term liabilities

Resources may come from taxes (either levied by DSF or levied by GF then transfered to DSF), special assessments, or

Usually only have one DSF for all tax supported debt, but if there are legal restrictions then there may be more
