Jupyter shortcuts	
> jupyter notebook &	command from console opens jupyter in new browser tab; & runs it in background
New ▼ -> Python3	opens a new notebook in Python3
pwd	shows current working directory
Shift+Enter	runs code in a cell
Tab	shows methods on an object
Shift+Tab	shows help docstring
help(topic)	shows help on topic
#	comments in Python code
""	multiline comments in Python
multiline "	

Lexical Tokens	
Operators	+, -, *, **, /, //, %, @, <<, >>, &, , ^, ~, <, >, <=, >=, ==, !=
Delimiters	() [] { } , : . ; @ = -> += -= = /= //= %= @= &= = ^= >>= <<= *=

Strings	
len('string')	gives length of string
str(:#)	slice from [#] to end of object str , noninclusive
str(#:)	slice from the beginning of str to [#] noninclusive
