> jupyter notebook &	command from console opens jupyter in new browser tab; & runs it in background
New ▾ -> Python3	opens a new notebook in Python3
pwd	shows current working directory
Shift+Enter	runs code in a cell
Tab	shows methods on an object
Shift+Tab	shows help docstring
help(<i>topic</i>)	shows help on <i>topic</i>
#	comments in Python code
""" <i>multiline</i> """	multiline comments in Python

Lexical Tokens

Operators	+, -, *, **, /, //, %, @, <=, >=, <, >, &, , ^, ~, <, >, <=, >=, ==, !=
Delimiters	() [] { } , : . ; @ = -> += -= /= // = %= @= &= /= ^= >>= <<= *=

Strings

len('string')	gives length of string
str(:#)	slice from [#] to end of object <i>str</i> , noninclusive
str(##)	slice from the beginning of <i>str</i> to [#] noninclusive
