

Jupyter shortcuts

> **jupyter notebook &** command from console opens jupyter in new browser tab; **&** runs it in background

New ▾ -> Python3 opens a new notebook in Python3

pwd shows current working directory

Shift+Enter runs code in a cell

Tab shows methods on an object

Shift+Tab shows help docstring

help(*topic*) shows help on *topic*

comments in Python code

""" multiline comments in Python

Delimiters () [] { } , : . ; @ = -> += -= /= // = %= @= &= /= ^= >>= <<= *=

Strings

len('string') gives length of string

str(:#) slice from [#] to end of object *str*, noninclusive

str(##) slice from the beginning of *str* to [#] noninclusive
