Nouns: Grammatical cases	* seven grammatical cases
Nominative case (Nom.):	* "basis" case: is used when the noun is the subject of the sentence – the entity that is doing something
	* does not have any special ending: basic form of the word
Verbs: Present Tense	* three basic tenses for indicating past, present and future
	* polish verbs conjugate
	* "He drinks <i>and</i> He is drinking* are translated the same into Polish
Articles	* Polish does not have any articles
