slow-**s** lowly, patient-**ly** patiently, carefully

change spelling
easy-**e** easily, terrible-**ly** terribly

good-**well**, fast-**fast**, hard-**hard**,
early-**early**, late-**late**

negative I/you/she/he/it/we/they mustn't
eat in the classroom.

talk about necessary things

can't do because we don't have permission

affirmative i/you/we/they **have to** wear a
uniform. she/he **has to** wear a
uniform.

negative i/you/we/they **don't have to** go to
school. he/she **doesn't have to**
go to school
