

### adverbs of manner

#### Regular adverbs

we add *-ly* to the adjective

slow-ly, patient-ly, attentively, carefully, fully

change spelling

easy-ly, terribly, lightly

uitzonderingen

good-ly, fast-ly, hard-ly, early-ly, late-ly

we use adverbs of manner to describe (bijvoeglijk naamwoord) how we do something

### must/mustn't

affirmative i/you/she/he/it/we/they must come to class.

negative I/you/she/he/it/we/they mustn't eat in the classroom.

#### use

talk about necessary things

can't do because we don't have permission

is niet gebruikelijk voor vragen

### have to/don't have to

affirmative i/you/we/they **have to** wear a uniform. she/he **has to** wear a uniform.

negative i/you/we/they **don't have to** go to school. he/she **doesn't have to** go to school
