Windows users	Ctrl+Q

Search notebooks

Notebook	Notebook:[name of notebook]
Multi word notebook	Notebook:"[name of notebook]"

Searching tags

Include	Tag:[tag word]
exclude	-Tag:[tag word]
wildcard	Tag:[tag name]*
multi word	Tag:"[tag word]"
Tagged notes	Tag:*
Untagged notes	-Tag:*

For the wildcard, the asterisk must be at the end.

Note titles

include Title	Intitle:[name of note]
exclude title	-Intitle:[name of note]
Multi word	Intitle:"[name of note]"

Search source

Email	Source:mail.smtp
Web page	Source:web.clip
Mobile	source:Mobile.[*,Iphone,Android]
Application	Source:App.*

General search

Include	[yourtext]
exclude	-[yourtext]
multi word	"your text"
Wildcard	[Your te]*

This will search the body, title, and tags.

search resource

Audio	resource:audio/*
Image	resource:image/*
Handwritten	Recotype:handwritten
Picture	Recotype:picture
Speech	Recotype:speech
Printed	Recotype:printed
Unknown	Recotype:unknown

To search for certain formats (mp3,png,jpeg,etc) remove the asterisk and fill in the format

To-Do lists

all To-Do lists	Todo:*
Checked boxes	Todo:true
Unchecked boxes	Todo:false

There only needs to be at least one checked or unchecked to show up.

Searching dates

Created date	created:day
Updated date	updated:day
Use these after(with no space after the colon) of iether created: or updated:	
Date	YYYYMMDD
Date and time	YYYYMMDDT090000
Today	Day
Yesterday	Day-1
7 Days ago	Day-7
This week	Week
Last week	Week-1
This month	Month
Last month	Month-1
This year	Year
Last year	Year-1
Older then today	-day
