

### 1.1 Syntax and Structure

#### Print Statement

JavaScript uses `console.log()` to output information to the console. You can print strings, variables, or the result of calculations.

```
console.log( " Hello, World! "); // Outputs: Hello, World!
```

#### Comments

JavaScript supports single-line comments (`//`) and multi-line comments (`/* */`).

```
// Single-line comment
