General Advice

The Baseline for Marriage

1. **Spiritual Commonality** More than just believing in God. You must align on major doctrines. **2 Corinthians 6:14, 1 Peter 3:8**

2. **Family Unity** If both sets of parents do not like each other that is a problem. Marriage is not only the union of two people but a union of two families. **John 17:21**

3. **Things in Common** You will be old and wrinkly when you are 80. You should like to do similar things so that you have more to do than just eating. **Philippians 2:1-2**

4. **Physical Chemistry** Most people put this first and ignore the first three. The first three are more important. **Proverbs 11:22**

The Role of The Husband

1. To love the Lord God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength. To love others.

Mark 12:30, Matthew 22:39

2. To love his wife sacrificially and teach her the word of God. **Ephesians 5:25-27**

3. To dwell with the wife in an understanding way as the weaker vessel. **1 Peter 3:7**

4. To provide and protect. **1 Timothy 5:8, Matthew 12:29**

The Role of The Wife

1. To love God with all her heart, soul, mind, and strength. To love others. **Mark 12:30, Matthew 22:39**

2. To submit to her husband in everything. **Ephesians 5:22-24**

3. To be a keeper of the home. **Titus 2:5**

4. To be a helper to her husband. **Genesis 2:18**

How to Find a Spouse

Go to church. Join a singles Bible study. Serve the Lord at church or in a faith based charity.

Guys, get a job that has an income that can support a family. When things go wrong, help others.

Girls, help your mother and be a keeper of the home. Honor your father and mother.

What to Look for In A Husband

What to Look for In A Husband (cont)

Look for a guy who loves sacrificially. Does he come to the rescue like a knight in shining armor when things go wrong and you need help? **Ephesians 5:25-27**

What to Look for in a Wife

Reject a girl that desires to have sex before marriage. **1 Corinthians 6:9**

Look for a girl that loves the Lord. A girl that loves the Lord serves the Lord. Attending church is not enough. **1 Samuel 12:24**

Look for a submissive girl. A girl that is disobedient to her father will be disobedient to you. **Ephesians 6:1-3, Proverbs 21:9**

Look for a girl that desires to be a keeper of the home. Look for a girl that desires to multiply with children. Reject a girl that desires a career instead of children.

Strength and Honor Show initiative each day to honor your spouse with words and actions. **Philippians 2:3**
