

Loop

```
<li v-for="task in tasks">{{ task }}</li>
```

Normal Directive

```
<div v-if="ok"></div>
```

Directive with argument

```
<button v-on:click="onClick"></button>
```

v-on with argument + key modifier

```
<input v-on:keyup.enter="handleEnter">
```

Shorthand @ for v-on

```
<button @click="onClick"></button>
```

```
<input @keyup.enter="handleEnter">
```

Bind class attribute

```
<li :class="task.completed">{{ task.name }}</li>
```

Use array:

```
<li :class="['one', 'two', 'three']">
  {{ task.name }}
</li>
```

Array with conditional class:

```
<li :class="['one', 'two', something ? 'three'
: '']">
  {{ task.name }}
</li>
```

Use object:

```
<li :class="{ 'completed': task.completed }">
  {{ task.name }}
</li>
```
