

### Definition

According to the Merriam Webster dictionary, feedback is "the transmission of evaluative or corrective information about an action, event, or process to the original or controlling source."

### Recommendations when giving feedback.

- 1.- Do not wait until the end of the course or program to give feedback. feedback can be giving after every activity.
- 2.- Be positive and honest when giving feedback.
- 3.- Give feedback in different ways, do not repeat the same phrase over and over. if you have to go deeper for the student to get that he/she needs to improve, do it.

### Techniques to give Feedback.

- 1.- Approach your students with a good attitude, do not intimidate them or offensive.
- 2.- Corrective Feedback: tell your students the areas they need to improve and help them how to improve.
- 3.- Understanding and supportive feedback: this kind of feedback is to cheer up our students not to punish them. Give them time to express needs and feelings about the class.
- 4.- Constructive and not-judgmental Feedback: teacher allows the students to make mistakes by making sure the students know that mistakes are crucial when learning.



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
