S/S: Chest pain - pressure, heavy, tight, radiating to left shoulder.	S/S: Chest pain, crackles, edema, pink-frothy sputum, JVD	S/S: Chest pain, fever, fatigue, muscle & joint pain, late: edema & SOB	S/S: Headache, chest pain, fever > 38°C, rash, joint pain	S/S: Throbbing pain - head, severe symptoms, global STE, friction rub	S/S: JVD, delayed onset headache, seizures	S/S: Delayed onset headache, seizures	S/S: Drooping eyelids, slurred speech, arm/face weakness, visual disturbances, anisocoria	S/S: Facial droop, arm/face weakness, sensory deficits, homonymous hemianopia, LOC	S/S: Brief jerking movements, tonic phase, clonic phase, CSF leakage, unequal pupils, odd resp. patterns	S/S: (Basilar) Full blown tonic phase, CSF leakage, unequal pupils, odd resp. patterns	S/S: Throbbing	S/S: Throbbing
