Hypertension (cont)

Diuretic Combinations Hydrochlorothiazide/Amiloride, Hydrochlorothiazide/Triamterene, Hydrochlorothiazide/Spironolactone

Hypertension (High Blood Pressure): A condition where the force of blood against the artery walls is consistently too high.

Depression

Selective Serotonin Reuptake Inhibitors Citalopram, Escitalopram, Fluoxetine, Fluvoxamine, Paroxetine (Immediate, Controlled-release), Sertraline

Serotonin-Norepinephrine Reuptake Inhibitors Desvenlafaxine, Duloxetine, Levomilnacipran, Venlafaxine

Serotonin Modulators Trazodone, Vilazodone, Vortioxetine

Tricyclic Antidepressants Amitriptyline, Clomipramine, Desipramine, Doxepin, Imipramine, Nortriptyline, Trimipramine

Natural Health Products S-adenosylmethionine

Depression: A mood disorder that causes a persistent feeling of sadness and loss of interest and can interfere with your daily activities

Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder

Amphetamine-based Agents Dextroamphetamine (Immediate, Sustained - release tablets), Lisdexamfetamine, Mixed Salt Amphetamine (Extended Release)

Methylphenidate-based Agents Methylphenidate (Immediate, Sustained, Controlled, Bilayer Controlled - release tablets)

Alpha2-Adrenergic Agonists Clonidine, Guanfacine

Antidepressants, dual action Bupropion

Antidepressants, serotonin-norepinephrine reuptake inhibitors (SNRIs) Venlafaxine

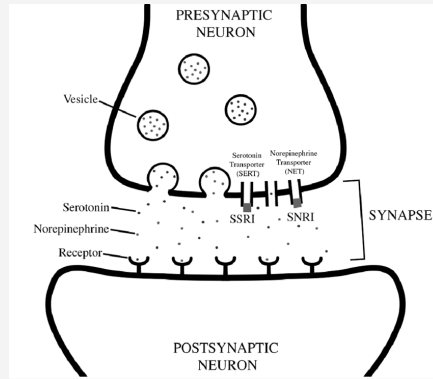
Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (cont)

Norepinephrine Reuptake Inhibitors

Atomoxetine

Attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD): The most common pediatric neuropsychiatric disorder causing inattention, hyperactivity and impulsivity

Serotonin & Norepinephrine Reuptake Inhibitor



A class of antidepressants that work by blocking the reuptake of the neurotransmitter norepinephrine and dopamine, thus increasing their levels in the brain

Rheumatoid Arthritis (RA): A chronic autoimmune disease that primarily affects joints, causing pain, swelling and stiffness

Nonsteroidal Anti-inflammatory Agents	Diclofenac Diethylamine, Diclofenac Sodium
Corticosteroids, Intra-articular	Betamethasone acetate/betamethasone sodium phosphate, Triamcinolone acetonide, Methylprednisolone acetate
Corticosteroid/Synovial Fluid Replacement, Intra-articular	Hyaluronic acid/triamcinolone hexacetonide
Synovial Fluid Replacement	Sodium hyaluronate

Osteoarthritis: Most common type of arthritis, characterized by the gradual breakdown of cartilage in joints (Common affected areas: spine, hands, hips or knees)

Osteoporosis

Biphosphonates	Alendronate, Risedronate, Zoledronic Acid
Biphosphonates + Nutritional Supplements	Alendronate/Vitamin D
Calcitonin Peptides	Calcitonin salmon, subcutaneous
Nutritional Supplements	Calcium, Vitamin D
RANK Ligand Inhibitors	Denosumab
Selective Estrogen Receptor Modulators	Raloxifene, Conjugated estrogen/bazedoxifene

Osteoporosis: A skeletal disorder characterized by compromised bone strength predisposing a person to an increased risk of fracture (weakened bone)
