

### General Commands

|                          |   |
|--------------------------|---|
| show databases           | Show all databases                      |
| use <database>           | Select a database for usage             |
| show collections         | Show all collections in a database      |
| db                       | Shortcut to the currently used database |
| db.<collection>.remove() | Truncate (empty) a collection           |

### Update where all documents with field matches

```
db.<collection>.update({
  storeID: ObjectId("<id_here>")
},
{
  $set: {
    storeID: ObjectId("<id_here>")
  }
},
{
  multi: true
})
```

The multi allows multiple documents to be updated. If you do not specify \$set it will remove all other fields but the one you specified changes to, **do not forget to use \$set**

### Rename Database

|  |   |
|--|---|
| db.copyDatabase('old_name', 'new_name'); | Copy the database to a new database       |
| use <old_name>                           | Switch to the database you wish to delete |
| db.dropDatabase();                       | Destroys the selected database            |

There is no native way to rename a database, use these commands together to accomplish this.

### Export and Import Databases

```
mongodump -d <database_name> -o <directory_backup> -h <host> --port <port> -u <user> -p
mongorestore <director_backup>
```
