Josef Stalin	Became in power after Valdimir Lenin died in 1924 sick in 1922 after strokes

Which one played a role in October war?	Trosky played a significant role he was the Right hand man of Lenin

What kind of leader was he?	tortured people, jailed people for crimes even if they didn't commit them. Russia went into a political repression.
