Paresthetica = the compression of the Lateral femoral cutaneous nerve as it passes through the inguinal ligament. \*Causes shooting pain down the lateral aspect of the thigh

\*Common in gymnasts, scuba divers = when clothing is too tight and compresses inguinal ligament
