Features

Magna Carta of India

Justiciable

Not absolute

Directs the state about it's responsibilities

Available to citizens only - 15, 16, 19, 29, 30

Protects vertically against the state

Most of them are self-executory

Article 13

Article 13 - deals with the amenability of FRs

Expressively provides doctrine of Judicial Review

All the laws that are inconsistent with or in derogation of any FR shall be void.
