Mexican Revolution

in the americas

1910-1920

partially caused by the **treaty of tordesailles** (1494) *the treaty that gave the spanish control over all of the west except brazil*25 million natives down to 1
million due to disease

Early history

societies in the north american & canadian region tended to be smaller & less sophisticated then Mexico & south america

this was due to the slowness of the northward spread of corn cultivation from Mexico

non sustainable food source = less people

lived in semi-permanent settlements in groups of around 300

men made tools & potential
hunted while patricwomen gathered archy,
plants & nuts & men
grew crops dominated

cultures of languages

the native americans were very diverse New mexico & arizona	branched off to create more than 20 seperate language families lived in caves, under cliffs, & multistoreied buildings
Pacific coast	rich & diverse diet: hunting, fishing, gathering nuts, berries, & roots; carved totem poles to keep record of stories
Great plains	nomadic hunters & sedentary peoples, farmed & traded, lived in teepees: easily deconstructable for travel

Early history

first people to arrive in the americas arrived arpund 40,000 years ago

migrated from Asia through the land bridge between Siberia and Alaska (is now under water)

Mayas built extensive cities in the rainforests of the Yucatan Peninsula
