<code>pwd</code>	Print Working Directory
<code>cd <i>dir</i></code>	Change Directory to <i>dir</i>
<code>mkdir <i>name</i></code>	Make Directory in current Directory
<code>mkdir -p</code>	Make new nested directories
<code>rmdir</code>	Remove directory
<code>rm -rf</code>	Remove directory and content (forced)
<code>cp -R</code>	Copies one directory and its files to another directory
<code>tree</code>	Shows the subdirectories

### Accessing Consoles

<code>tty</code>	terminal that you connect to
<code>who</code>	who is currently logged

### Listing Files

<code>ls</code>	List files and directories
<code>ls -a</code>	List files and directories including hidden
<code>ls -aF</code>	List files and directories including hidden and file types
<code>ls /etc</code>	List files and directories of the server's configuration directory
<code>ls -l</code>	List files and directories showing more details
<code>ls -ltr</code>	List files and directories with the last modified at the end
<code>ls -lh</code>	List files and directories in a more readable format
<code>ls -ld</code>	Lists the file directory file type
<code>ls -lR</code>	Lists files and directories Recursevely
<code>ls -l1</code>	Lists files and directories 1 per line
<code>ls -lm</code>	Lists files and directories comma separated
