### Basic edits (cont)

⌃ + ⌘ + v	Paste and match style
⌘ + ⌘ + d	Duplicate layer or selected area

### Style tool

⇧ + +	Change brush hardness
⇧ + -	Cycle through blending modes

### Arrange tool

Left click + Move the mouse	Drag a layer handle; resize a layer
⌘ + Left click + move the mouse	Duplicate a layer
⌃ + Left click	Duplicate a layer

### Work with layers

⌘ + ⌘ + n	Create an empty new layer
⌫ (delete)	Delete selected layer(s)
⌃ + ⌘ + a	Select all layers
⌃ + ⌘ + e	Merge selected layers
⌃ + ⌘ + ⌘ + e	Merge all layers
⌘ + g	Group layers
⌘ + ⌘ + g	Ungroup layers
⌘ + ]	Bring selected layer(s) forward
⌃ + ⌘ + [	Send selected layer(s) to the front
⌘ + 8	Bring selected layers backward
⌃ + ⌘ + ]	Send selected layer(s) to the back
⌘ + Move the mouse + left click	Drag the layer: Move a layer while any tool is a

### Clone tool

⌃ + Left click	Set clone source

### Shapes and vectors

u	Draw a rectangle shape
Shift	Press and hold the Shift ( ⌘ ) key before starting to draw: Unite a shape with the selected shape.
⌃	Press and hold the Option ( ⌂ ) key before starting to draw: Subtract a shape from the selected shape.
⌃ + Shift	Press and hold the Option ( ⌂ ) and Shift ( ⌘ ) key before starting to draw: Intersect a shape with the selected shape.

### Arrange tool

Left click + Move the mouse	Drag a layer handle: Resize a layer
⌘ + Left click + Move the mouse or ⌃ + Left click + Move the mouse	Duplicate a layer
⌘ + Move the mouse + Left click	Disable alignment guides while moving or resizing
⌃ + Move the mouse + Left click	Drag a layer handle: Resize a layer from the center
⌘ + Move the mouse + Left click	Drag a layer handle: Constrain the aspect ration when resizing a layer
⌃ + ⌘ + Left click + Move the mouse	Constrain the aspect ratio when resizing a layer from the center
⌘ + Move the mouse + Left click	Click the layer: Open the shortcut menu for the selected layer
⌘ + Move the mouse + Left click	Drag a layer handle: Rotate a layer
⌘ + ⌘ + move the mouse + Left click	Drag a layer handle: Rotate a layer in 15° increments
⌘ + Left Click + Move the mouse	Drag a layer: Move a layer in a straight or diagonal line

### Paint and erase

d	Reset foreground and background colors to white and black
x	Switch between foreground and background color
⇧ + Left click	Paint or erase in a straight line
Double click	(Double click a brush) Open brush settings
⇧ + Left click	Paint a straight line
⇧ + Move the mouse	Paint vertical or horizontal lines
, or .	Navigate through the brushes
[ or ]	Increase or decrease brush size
⇧ + [ or ⇧ + ]	Change brush hardness
⇧ + Left click + move the mouse	Drag gradient: Constrain gradient to 15° angle
⌃ + Left click	Pick a color from your image
⌘ + ⌂ (delete)	Fill layer with foreground color
⌃ + ⌂ (delete)	Fill layer with background color
