Causative-Passive Form "I was made; forced to do (something)" -One is forced to do something and the speaker is the victim -If you want to give a nuance that the subject is the victim and was forced to do something -Has a nuance that you are taking on the subject/victim's side or talking from his/her perspective. You are kind of upset that she was forced to do something by someone. -Include a bad feeling for the subject for being forced to do something -Used when you talk about from your perspective or someone else's perspective DDONTs: V-てくれる cannot be attached to this grammar -Verbs ending with す, ら should not be omitted in あさせられる。 D (Doer-Victim) は (Coercer) に (Direct Object) を (Causative-P-(Doer-Victim) は (Coercer) に (Causative-Passive Verb) = NO Direct Object assive Verb) = With Direct Object 子供達はお母さんに嫌いな野菜を食べさせられる。 彼女は彼に泣かされました。 The kids will be forced by the mom to eat veggies they don't He made her cry. Combined with Other Conjugation *ても:Even if* 僕は 3 時間で待たされてもいきます。 Even if I am made to wait for 3 hours, I'll go. *V-たらいい:Giving Advice*

It's good if you are forced to speak in Japanese.

V-たことがない: Experience of non having to do something before
