- 1. Nominalize verbs / verb clauses

Similar Grammar:

わけ = Outright Conclusion (based on what the speaker saw or heard)

1.1 meaning. "Should; I expect" is used for expectations, not suggestions or advice. It should happen based on your judgment

*1.2 meaning. "It should be; I expect; It's supposed to be" Not so sure but Z

1.3 meaning そのは ず "I suppose so; it should be; It is so"*
