【なんて/なんか】

Noun + なんて / なんか Expresses the speaker's hatred / distaste / all the negative feelings towards the noun in front of it.

Adds a sense of resentment / emotion. This is nothing like swearing so you don't need to worry about sounding rude. This is just more emotional.

Differences between なんか and なんて

- 1. Verb / Adj なんて / なんか = Expresses negative feelings about Verb / Adj
- 2. なんか can be used infront if many different particles
- 3. なんか = NEGATIVE、なんて = POSITIVE / NEGATIVE things
