

### 【なんて / なんか】

Noun + **なんて / なんか** Expresses the speaker's hatred / distaste / all the negative feelings towards the noun in front of it.

Adds a sense of resentment / emotion. This is nothing like swearing so you don't need to worry about sounding rude. This is just more emotional.

### Differences between **なんか** and **なんて**

1. Verb / Adj **なんて / なんか** = Expresses negative feelings about Verb / Adj
2. **なんか** can be used in front of many different particles
3. **なんか** = NEGATIVE、**なんて** = POSITIVE / NEGATIVE things

### 2. 'I' + **なんて/なんか** to sound modest

**私/僕/俺 + なんて / なんか**

"Someone like me"

私なんか試験に受からないよ。 Someone like me can't pass the exam.

私なんかと付き合いたい？ Do you really want to go out with someone like me?

### 1 meaning. "To express negative emotions"

**N + なんか**

"Such thing as" "Someone like" "Something like"

A. ママ、今年はサンタさんからPS5が欲しいの。 Mommy, this year I want a PS5 from Santa.

B. サンタさんなんかいないの。 There is no such thing as Santa.

仕事なんか【辞めたい】やめたい。 I want to quit my job.

サラダにきゅうりなんか入れないで。 Don't put any dang cucumbers in my salad.

**N + なんて**

"Such thing as" "Someone like" "Something like"

コロナなんてくそくらえ。 Fuck Coronavirus.

私のハンバーガーにピクルスなんていらぬ。 I don't need any pickles in my hamburger.

A. 一万円でいい？ Is 10,000 (\$100) yen fine?

B. お金なんていらぬ。謝って！ I don't need your stupid money! Apologize!

!□!□ Expresses the speaker's hatred / distaste / all the negative feelings towards the noun in front of it.

百万年**なんか**持ってない。No way I have 1 million yen (\$10,000).

今月は50万円**も**【稼ぐ】かせげた。I was able to earn as much as 500,000 yen this month. // 【稼ぐ】かせぐ : to earn
