Ctrl+Shift+N	create new terminal window
Ctrl+Shift+T	add a new tab
Ctrl+Shift+W	close current tab
Ctrl+PgUp	goto prev. tab
Ctrl+PgDn	goto next tab
Alt+n	goto the <i>n</i> th tab
Super+Ctrl+Mouse	mark column block

BASH Shell

Super+Ctrl+Mouse	mark text block
Ctrl+K	cut text from cursor to EOL
Ctrl+U	cut text from SOL to cursor
Ctrl+W	delete prev. word
Ctrl+Y	paste prev. cut text
Ctrl+A	goto SOL
Ctrl+E	goto EOL
Ctrl+cursor-left	move cursor to prev. word
Ctrl+cursor-right	move cursor to next word
SOL=start of line / EOL=end of line	

Nautilus

Shift+Ctrl+N	create new folder
Shift+Enter	open selected folder as new tab
F2	rename selected file
Ctrl+I	show information of selected file
Ctrl+H	toggle display of hidden files on/off
Ctrl+W	close Nautilus windows
Ctrl+Q	close <i>all</i> Nautilus windows

Ctrl+L	Go to URL locator
