Summary

Beasts of the Southern Wild is an American independent film directed by Ben Zeitlin starring Quvenzhané Wallis and Dwight Henry.

A little girl named Hushpuppy lives with her father in a bayou outside of Louisiana. Hushpuppy's father falls ill along with the bayou; temperatures rise making the ice caps melt and the beasts called aurochs start to roam around.
